What is a SITE MEETING? A meeting with contractors and the owner to check on progress throughout a building project. If it's a new building, they inspect what has been built. If it's an upgrade or re-modelling, then they check the addition or installation. If there has been a storm, they check damages, and make plans for demolition and rebuilding.
We need to do a 'Site Meeting' assessment of our lives on a regular basis. Here are 12 essential areas to build a great house:
We recommend that you take time once a month to evaluate each area.  1. Score each with a grade A – D  (Awesome! Beautiful progress. Change needed. Danger if things continue.)  2. Choose one or two areas to focus on that month and write down one sentence on how to improve in that area.
